Australian Land Tour details

Friday 16-Oct-20

Arrive Sydney (L)

Upon disembarking from your cruise ship please make your way to the arrivals area where you will be met by a local guide who will accompany you on a Sydney Opera House Tour, Luncheon Cruise and half day sightseeing tour on route to your hotel.

You will be transferred by private coach from the cruise ship terminal to the coach bay close to Sydney Opera House. The Opera House tour (approx. 45mins) offers the opportunity to experience the Sydney Opera House in its daily operation. Upon arrival at the Sydney Opera House, please check in at the Cloak Room Desk located on the Lower Concourse. Your tour then departs from the Lower Concourse located downstairs outside the Sydney Opera House Shop. Visitors are guided into theatres, given a fascinating account of the history and architecture of the House and introduced to the magic of performance. With its white, sculptural 'shells' rising from the harbour foreshore at Bennelong Point, the Opera House is Sydney's most recognisable building and, officially, one of the seven wonders of the 20th century. Joern Utzon, the Danish architect who designed the Opera House, ascribed the inspiration for his masterpiece to the sails of yachts on the harbour. As the Opera House is first and foremost a performing arts centre, some areas may be restricted for viewing due to rehearsals and performances.

After the tour your guide will accompany you on foot to the nearby Jetty 6 at Circular Quay for a Luncheon Cruise in Sydney harbour. Your cruise with Captain Cook Cruises departs 12.30pm. Sydney Harbour is one of the most scenic harbours in the world. You will see spectacular views of Sydney Harbour Bridge, Circular Quay, The Rocks, Opera House, Fort Denison, Point Piper, Watson's Bay. See Sydney's foreshore parkland and many stately homes. Enjoy the live commentary while you feast on a smorgasbord of fine Australian cuisine. The buffet features the finest selection of Australian meats, fresh seafood, roast vegetables, salads, coffee and tea. Dine indoors and then if you like you can take in the scenery from the viewing deck. The cruise returns to Circular Quay at 2.20pm.

Following the lunch cruise, re-board your private coach for a half day sightseeing Tour. Drive through the historic 'Rocks' area where Australia was first founded with its maze of terrace houses, restored warehouses, pubs and restaurants. Drive under the famous 'coat hanger', the Sydney Harbour Bridge and view Sydney's famous architectural masterpiece, the Sydney Opera House. Continue through the commercial area of the city passing the historical buildings of Macquarie Street - Parliament House, The Mint and Hyde Park Barracks. Alight at Mrs Macquarie's Chair for breath taking views of the city and harbour. Proceed through cosmopolitan Kings Cross and exclusive garden suburbs to the Gap on the ocean headland at Watsons Bay. Return to the city via famous Bondi Beach and Paddington, a Victorian suburb of restored terrace houses richly decorated with cast-iron lace. The tour concludes at the hotel approximately at 6:30pm.

Saturday 17-Oct-20 Full Day Blue Mountains Tour (BL)

Meet your Local Guide in the hotel Lobby who will accompany you on your Full Day Blue Mountains Tour. Tour includes: Entry to Featherdale Wildlife Park, Lunch at Mountain Heritage (beverages not included and at guests own expense) and Unlimited Discovery Pass to Scenic World.

Today you will travel 100km west of Sydney to the Blue Mountains. Follow the trail of Australia's early explorers as the coach ascends into the Blue Mountains National Park. Visit Featherdale. Featherdale is a Wildlife Park for a memorable and unique experience in a natural and well-established bush setting. Featherdale has one of Australia's largest private collections of Australian animals. View Koalas, kangaroos and wallabies, wombats, fairy penguins and Australian reptiles. The Blue Mountains, named for their distinctive blue haze (a result of eucalyptus oil evaporating from millions of gum trees), have long been a popular getaway destination for Sydneysiders. The mountains are a natural wonderland of untamed bush, spectacular rock formations and native wildlife. This is one of the most spectacular and captivating wilderness parks in the country, and a supreme example of Australia's diversity.

Travel through the historic townships of Blaxland, Springwood, Lawson and Wentworth Falls and view the National Trust township of Leura. Leura is a little town made up of cafes, craft shops, art galleries, tea houses and quant boutiques. It is situated at the edge of the Blue Mountain National Park and has magnificent views of Mt Solitary. Continue along Cliff Drive to Echo Point to view the world famous "Three Sisters". Perched on the edge of the escarpment, Echo Point precinct provides panoramic views of the southern Blue Mountains, Kanangra-Boyd Wilderness and the iconic Three Sisters rock formation from a variety of lookouts.

Enjoy lunch overlooking the stunning views and gardens of The Blue Mountains, The Mountain Heritage restaurant offers seasonal menu of fine Australian cuisine and comprehensive selection of quality Australian wines (beverages are not included).

Located at the World Heritage-listed Blue Mountains, Scenic World is renowned for providing the ultimate Blue Mountains Adventure - from native birds and fresh air, to breath taking views of the World Heritage-listed region including the Three Sisters, Katoomba Falls & Jamison Valley. The Unlimited Discovery Pass offers unlimited experience on the Railway, Skyway, Cableway and walkway. On your return to Sydney travel through Sydney Olympic Park before returning at your hotel.

Tuesday 20-Oct-20 **Full Day Kuranda Tours (BL)**

Meet your local guide in the hotel lobby who will accompany you on your full day Kuranda Tour. Tour includes: Scenic Rail from Freshwater Station to Kuranda (One way), Army Duck tour of the rainforest, Pamagirri Aboriginal Dancers, Dreamtime Walk & Cultural Centre, Koala & Wildlife Park, lunch at Rainforestation (Meal only, beverages not included) and One Way Skyrail Rainforest Cableway.

Board your Private Coach from the hotel to Freshwater Station. Depart Freshwater Station by Scenic Rail, the Kuranda Scenic Railway is a journey encompassing deep river gorges, rugged mountain ranges and spectacular waterfalls.

Arrive at Kuranda Station and reboard your Private Coach for transfer to Rainforestation Nature Park, boasting 40 hectares of gardens and rainforest set amidst World Heritage areas. Ride the amphibious army duck through the rainforest and visit the Koala and Wildlife Park.

The Dreamtime Walk provides a comprehensive introduction to Aboriginal and Islander culture and history with practical experiences including boomerang lessons on spear throwing. Witness the dynamic performance of the Pamagirri Aboriginal Dancers in the natural amphitheatre where the rainforest serves as the theatre walls and the sounds of the forest and the didgeridoo create the backing music.

Lunch will be served during the day

Board the Skyrail Rainforest Cableway for an amazing experience over Australia's World Heritage listed Tropical Rainforest canopy and deep into the forest. Your Skyrail experience should take approximately 1 ½ hours and includes spending time at the two rainforest mid-stations. Allow 20 minutes for each station, to enjoy Ranger guided boardwalk tours and visit the Rainforest Interpretation Centre, lookouts and historical displays. Transfer back to the Hotel by Private Coach

Wednesday 21-Oct-20 **Depart Cairns to Melbourne (B)**

Thursday 22-Oct-20 Half Day Sightseeing Tour (BD)

Meet your local Guide at the Hotel Lobby who will accompany you on your half day tour in Private Coach. Melbourne is Australia's cosmopolitan and sophisticated lifestyle capital, discover Melbourne's past and present. The drive will take in the central business district with its eclectic architecture, past the 170million dollar Victorian Arts Centre. View Captain Cook's Cottage in the beautiful Fitzroy Gardens with avenues of huge English elms planted along gently contoured lawns. Pass by the Botanical Gardens and observe the hustle and bustle of the famous Queen Victorian Markets. Continue along taking in views of the Shrine of Remembrance and St Patrick's Cathedral. The tour concludes at your hotel.

In the evening a group farewell dinner is included at the hotel restaurant (beverages are not included).


Friday 23-Oct-20 Departure Day (B)
